

The ESE Renewal Requirement

What Educators Need to Know

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What is 1012.585, F.S.?

- F.S. 1012.585 refers to the section of the **Florida legislative code** that stipulates **EVERY Florida educator** desiring to renew a teaching credential must earn **20** inservice points in **methods/strategies for teaching students with disabilities** in **EACH validity period**.
- These points are **PART OF** the **120** required for renewal every five years. **They are NOT in ADDITION to the 120.**
- Points may be earned in “pieces” or via one “whole.”
- One semester of college credit will = 20 inservice hours.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: EXAMINE YOUR TRANSCRIPT

To print a transcript of your inservice record, visit the district website at www.escambiaschools.org. Click on the **STAFF** tab, and scroll to "P": Click on **Performance Matters**.

Enter your **Novel username and password**.

Click on "**Certifications**."

Scroll down the page; your transcript will appear. It is in chronological order, with the most recent coursework appearing first.

Click "**Print**."

When you have the printed version of your transcript, determine when your validity period is, and count **ONLY** those points earned in that time frame. It may be helpful to use a highlighter.

Now, **examine the courses that fall within the validity period**. Look at the **third column from the right, "Component #,"** and **use the criteria on the next slide** to determine if the points are F.S. 1012.585 eligible or not.

DETERMINING F.S. 1012.585 ELIGIBILITY:

When examining the Master Inservice Plan (MIP) component number, look at the **SECOND, THIRD** and **FOURTH** digits of that number. The training will meet F.S. 1012.585 requirements **if** the **2nd, 3rd** and **4th** digits of the component number are:

100 or 101 or 102 or 105

Example:

2100045. This course **will** count.

Non-Example:

7405239. This course **will NOT** count.

PLEASE NOTE:

- **103 and 104 NEVER** count for F.S. 1012.585,
- **nor do Gifted and ASL courses, regardless** of code.
- **Anything advertised under the RIGHT code, but advertised as NOT counting, WILL NOT COUNT.**

My Example

FIRST, see if the course was taken IN the VALIDITY period.

SECOND, examine the component number for F.S. 1012.585 eligibility.

THIRD, add up the F.S. 1012.585-eligible points. You need 20.


